## ALBUTEROL



Other names:	Ventolin, Proventil
Type of Medicine:	Bronchodilator – relaxes muscles around the airways Quick relief or rescue medication
Why you need it:	For coughing or wheezing. To open up the airways.
How it is given:	Inhaler (puffer) Nebulized mist Liquid Pills
Side effects:	Nervousness Fast heart beat Hyperactivity Nausea/Vomiting

## **Tips for Taking**

- 1. Shake inhaler canister before use
- 2. Keep track of puffs used
- 3. Wait one minute between puffs
- 4. Use only when you are having problems with coughing or wheezing

## If you need to use your albuterol more than twice a week your asthma is NOT under control!
