Home Disposal, in Three Steps

- 1. Mix the medicine with something you wouldn't want to eat, like coffee grounds, used tea or kitty litter.
- 2. Put the mixture in a container and **seal it**.

 An empty margarine tub works great. Get creative!
- 3. Throw it away. Easy and safe!
